Getting to the Hotel from the Narita Airport

Narita Airport has two passenger terminals. Airlines use either Terminal 1 or Terminal 2, so your terminal number will depend on the airline you are using. Please confirm the location of your terminal before you arrive at the airport.

At the airport, you will emerge from the exit on the 1st floor of the terminal you will be arriving at. To get to Tsukuba City, it is most convenient to take an airport bus for Tsukuba Center/Tsuchiura. The bus, named "NATT'S line", departs from bus gate No. 8 (Terminal 1) and No. 10 (Terminal 2). Tickets (2,540yen) are available at the Keisei counter on the 1st floor in the Arrival Lobby of the terminals.


It will take about an hour and 40 minutes to get to the Tsukuba Center bus terminal.


